



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,615** new cases of COVID-19 on **19 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **457,228** with **9,330** deaths **(CFR: 2.04%)**. Out of the total **40,553** currently active cases **2,891** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Yesterday, 19th December 2020, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met with Secretary Health Southern Punjab Mr Muhammad Ajmal Bhatti in Multan. The Secretary Health briefed the WR on the health activities in Southern Punjab including integrated health services, Polio Eradication activities, and areas of collaboration between WHO and the Department of Health in Southern Punjab.

WR also met the WHO Provincial PEI and sub-office teams as well as the EPI & PEI field staff stationed in Southern Punjab districts. During the meeting field staff briefed the WR about the implementation of IPV campaign in DG Khan and Rajanpur districts, preparations for the upcoming Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine (TCV) campaign, strengthening of Permanent Transit Vaccination Points (PTPs), tracking and vaccination of children of high-risk mobile populations. WR appreciated the field staff for their support to strengthen the EPI and PEI activities and advised to enhance routine immunization coverage with good planning and practical approach.
