

### **Executive Summary**


Pakistan reported **640** new cases of COVID-19 on **19 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **305,671** with **6,416** deaths **(CFR: 2.10%)**. Out of the total **6,952** currently active cases, **837** cases are hospitalized, out of which **562 (67.14%)** are in critical condition. **6,115** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **292,303 (95.63%)** have recovered and discharged.





#### **Daily Incidence by Province**





#### **Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate**




#### **Maintaining Essential Health Services**



### Trends of COVID-19 confirmed cases









#### by Major Cities / Districts




### **Occupied COVID-19 ventilators**
