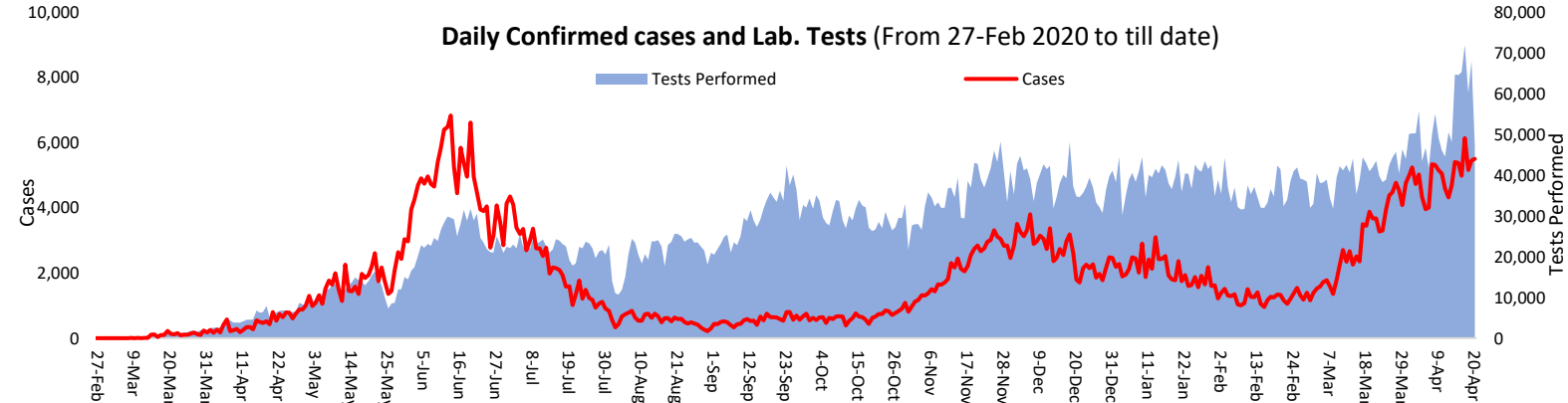

## Meeting and Coordination

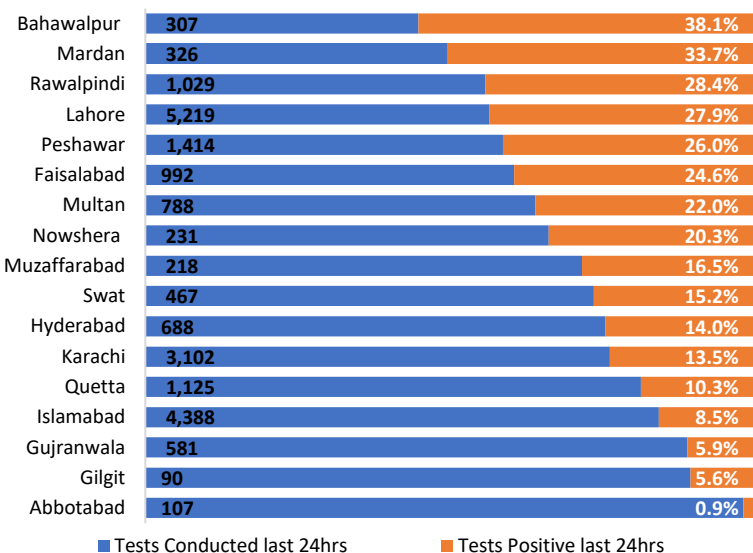


World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Health Department Punjab conducted a four days training (7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2021) for healthcare providers on Family Practice Approach and Community Engagement at District Health Development Center (DHDC) Kasur.

Participants for the training were from 30 Basic Health Units and included 30 Medical Officers, 29 Medical Technicians, 26 EPI technicians, 30 Lady Health visitors, 14 Lady health supervisors, 29 Dispensers and 30 Midwives. Chief Executive Officer Health, District Kasur Dr Javaid Iqbal and District Health Officer, Kasur, Dr Olakh appreciated WHO support for conducting this training at Kasur district. They also highlighted WHO support in the development of Universal Health Coverage Package for Pakistan.
