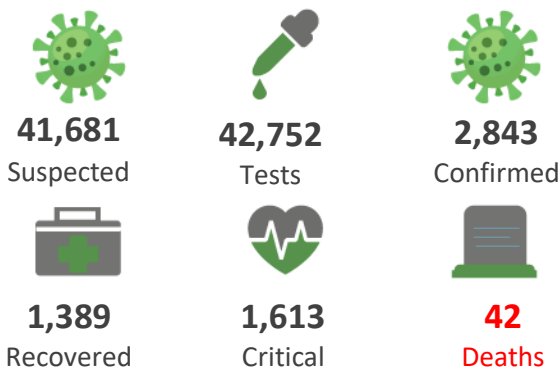


### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



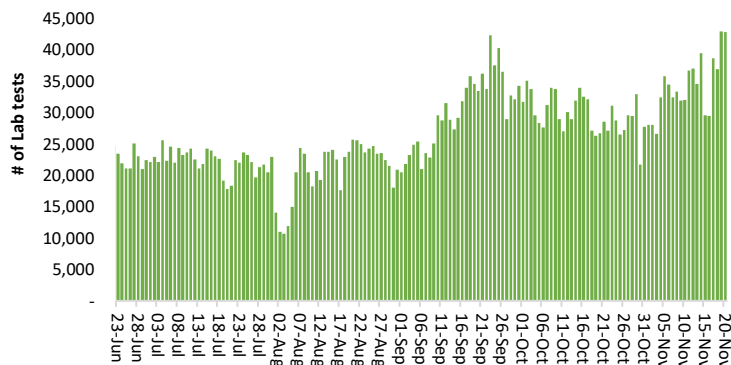
Pakistan reported **2,843** new cases of COVID-19 on **20 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **371,508** with **7,603** deaths (**CFR: 2.05%**). Out of the total **34,974** currently active cases, **2,122** cases are hospitalized.

### PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



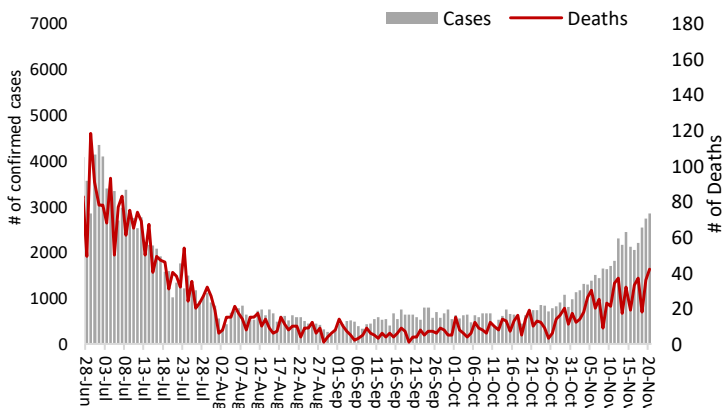

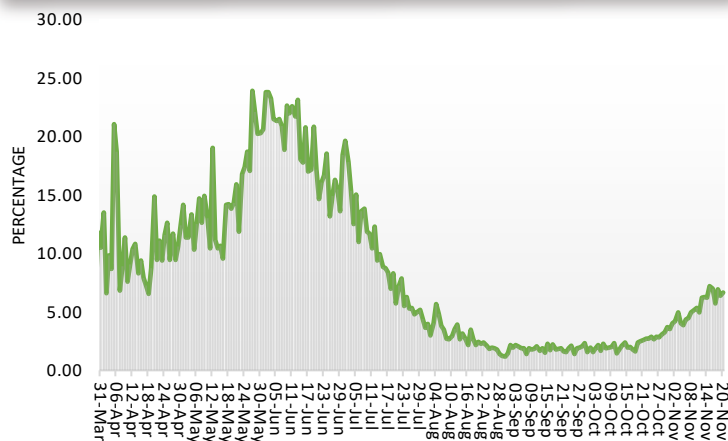


### INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

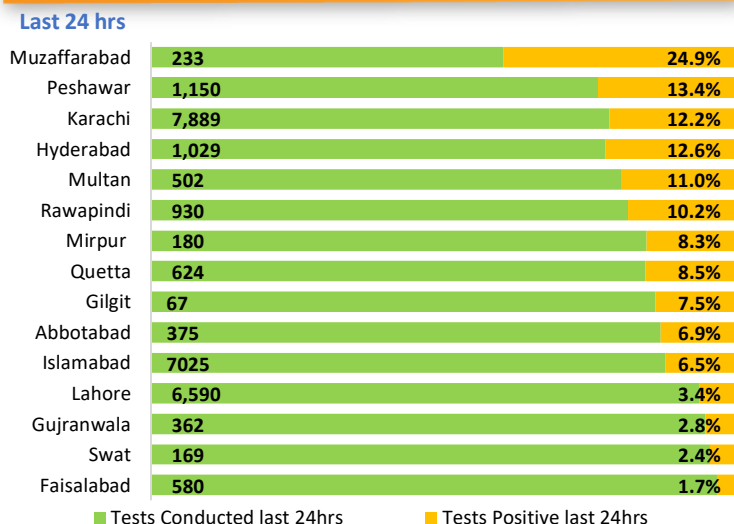

## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Yesterday, 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020, WHO country representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala met the Head of DFID, Ms Annabel Gerry and Senior Health Adviser (DFID), Dr Gillian Turner at WHO country office, Islamabad. WR briefed Ms. Annabel and Dr Turner on the current situation of COVID-19 in Pakistan. He also discussed the support WHO is giving to the government of Pakistan to respond to COVID-19. Dr. Palitha stressed on the urgent need to continue supporting the government specifically to strengthen surveillance, case diagnosis, IPC and risk communication and community engagement.

He further highlighted the importance of support to the Government of Pakistan in strengthening the health system to maintaining the essential health services considering Universal Health Care.
