

Summary Table by Province

On 20th November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited BHU Jhagra and Feeder Education School in Union Council Mera Kachori, District Peshawar, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Purpose of the visit was to monitor the progress of the ongoing Measles and Rubella (MR) campaign. Over 90 million children, age 9 months to 15 years are targeted for Vaccination countrywide. Children up to five years age will also receive the Oral Polio Vaccine. The WR was accompanied to the Sites by Assistant Commissioner Mr. Imran Khan, PEI Team Lead Dr Mohamed Geidi, Donor Coordination Officer Federal EPI Mr. Mossavir Ahmed, and Technical Officers from WHO and District Health teams.

During the site visits, the WR interacted with children, students, and their parents and, reviewed the campaign arrangements to ensure every child is vaccinated. Dr Palitha appreciated the frontline health workers for their commitment to a successful MR campaign.
