






#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**

Pakistan reported 1,792 new cases of COVID-19 on 20 December 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 458,968 with 9,392 deaths (CFR: 2.05%). Out of the total 40,491 currently active cases 2,925 cases are hospitalized.
