



#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **2,665** new cases of COVID-19 on **21 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **374,173** with **7,662** deaths **(CFR: 2.05%).** Out of the total **36,683** currently active cases, **2,139** cases are hospitalized.

### MEETINGS & COORDINATION
