

## **Executive Summary**

Pakistan reported **582** new cases of COVID-19 on **21 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **306,886** with **6,424** deaths **(CFR: 2.09%)**. Out of the total **7,303** currently active cases, **868** cases are hospitalized, out of which **570 (65.66%)** are in critical condition. **6,435** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **293,159 (95.52%)** have recovered and discharged.




## **Daily Incidence by Province**







# **Daily COVID-19 Attack rate**Per million population




## COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

### by Major Cities / Districts




### **Occupied COVID-19 ventilators**
