
# PAKISTAN CIVID-19 SITUATION REPORT

## **MEETING AND COORDINATION**

It's one year three days since the first virtual Country Support Team (CST) meeting was held between WHO country office Pakistan and technical officers from WHO EMRO. The Regional Director constituted the CST to work remotely with countries in the region and provide continuous support through daily communication.
