
PAKISTAN CIVID-19 SITUATION REPORT





Meeting and Coordination







On 21st May 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired the weekly meeting between the WHE team based in Islamabad and the 17 WHO Divisional Surveillance Officers for COVID-19 Response deployed in high burden districts. The objective of the meeting was to discuss the current upsurge of COVID-19 cases. During the meeting, all District Surveillance Officers briefed the WR on the current situation of COVID-19 in their respective districts, the trend analysis for SARI/ILI cases, contact tracing, case management and the health system capacity in the district.

Dr Palitha appreciated the hard work, dedication, and commitment of surveillance officers. He stated that surveillance is the eyes and ears of the healthcare system. He further emphasized on the importance of implementation of non-pharmaceutical interventions, strengthening of contact tracing and case management.
