

Executive Summary


Pakistan reported **532** new cases of COVID-19 on **22 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **307,418** with **6,432** deaths **(CFR: 2.09%)**. Out of the total **7,070** currently active cases, **880** cases are hospitalized, out of which **558 (63.41%)** are in critical condition. **6,190** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **293,916 (95.60%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence/Mortality




Daily COVID-19 Global Updates (Last 24hrs)




Maintaining Essential Health Services

Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




Daily COVID-19 Attack rate Per million population



Trends of COVID-19 confirmed cases







COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR by Major Cities / Districts




Occupied COVID-19 ventilators
