
PAKISTAN SITUATION REPORT





Meeting and Coordination



On 22nd May 2021 the office of the Director General Punjab Emergency Services (Rescue 1122), coordinated an awareness session on road safety in commemoration of the UN Global Road Safety Week (from 17th to 23rd May 2021).

The session that was held at the Governors' House, Punjab. The Special Advisor to Prime Minister (SAPM) on Health, Dr. Faisal Sultan who was the guest of honor; WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr. Palitha Mahipala; Governor Punjab, Chaudhary Muhammad Sarwar and Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Information and Broadcasting, Madam Firdous Ashiq Awan graced the occasion.
