


# PAKISTAN COVID-19 SITUATION REPORT



## **Meetings & Coordination**



On July 6, 2021, World Health Organization, Pakistan in collaboration with Ministry of NHSR&C and Foundation for Ageing and Inclusive Development conducted a webinar. The objective of this webinar was to highlight the Decade of Healthy Ageing Initiatives for the wellbeing of older people and the role of different stakeholders. The webinar was chaired by Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr Nousheen Hamid and WHO Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala. Key speakers included Dr Samra Mazhar from Ministry of NHSR&C, Ms Camilla Williamson from HelpAge International, Dr Asghar Zaidi from Government College University Lahore, Dr Yuka Sumi from WHO Geneva, and Dr Samar Elfeky from WHO EMRO. Dr Nousheen and Dr Palitha in their remarks highlighted the importance of focusing on healthy ageing as an essential step towards the achievement of SDGs. They welcomed the collaborations and encouraged other partners to join hands in supporting the country's initiatives on healthy ageing and to improve health status of older people in the country.
