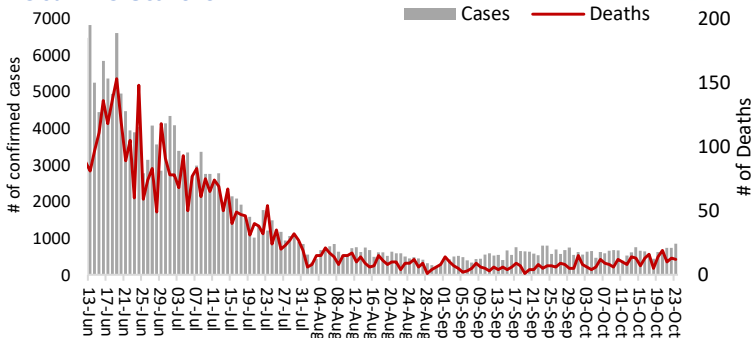

Executive Summary

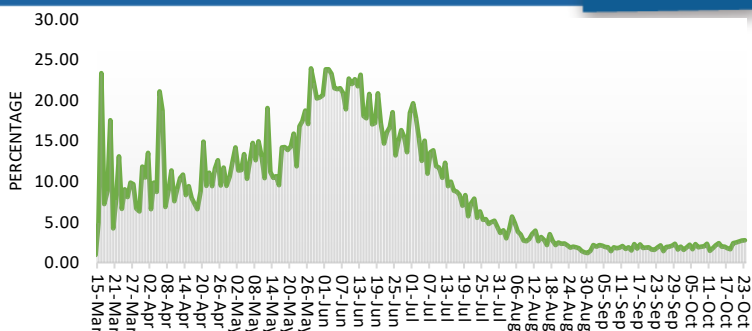
Pakistan reported **847** new cases of COVID-19 on **23 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **327,063** with **6,727** deaths (**CFR: 2.06%**). Out of the total **10,235** currently active cases, **849** cases are hospitalized, out of which **586 (69.02%)** are in critical condition. **9,386** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **310,101 (94.81%)** have recovered and discharged.

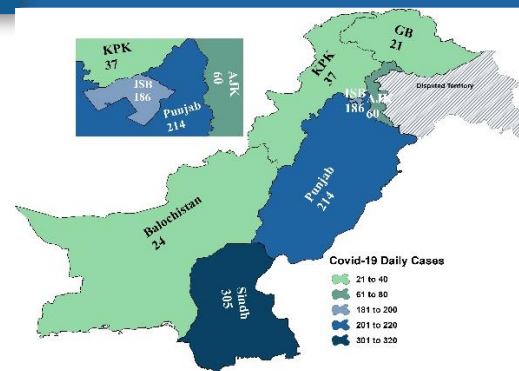

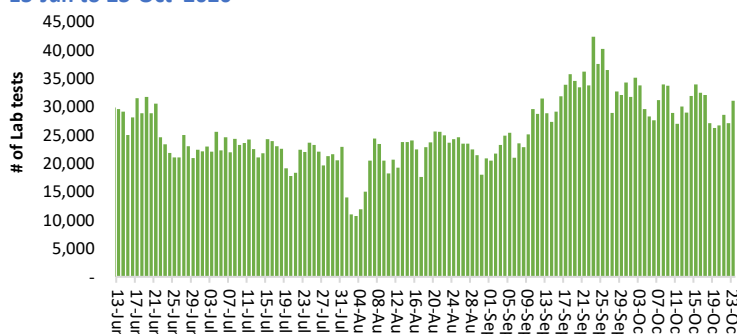

Daily Incidence by Province



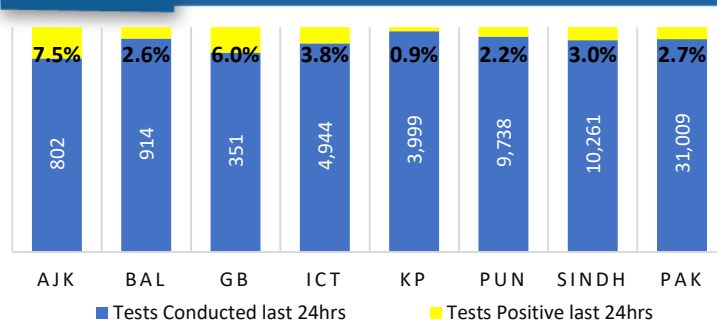

Meetings & Coordination

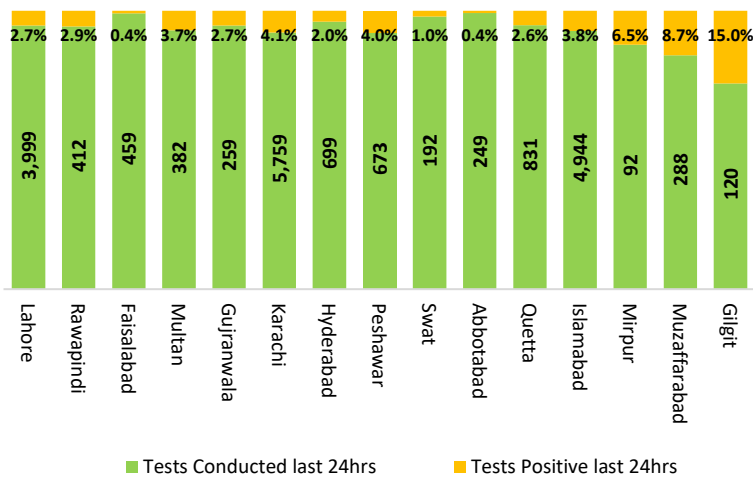
