

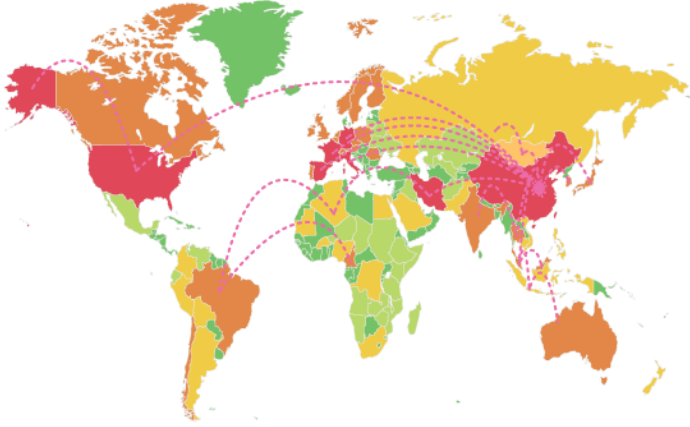

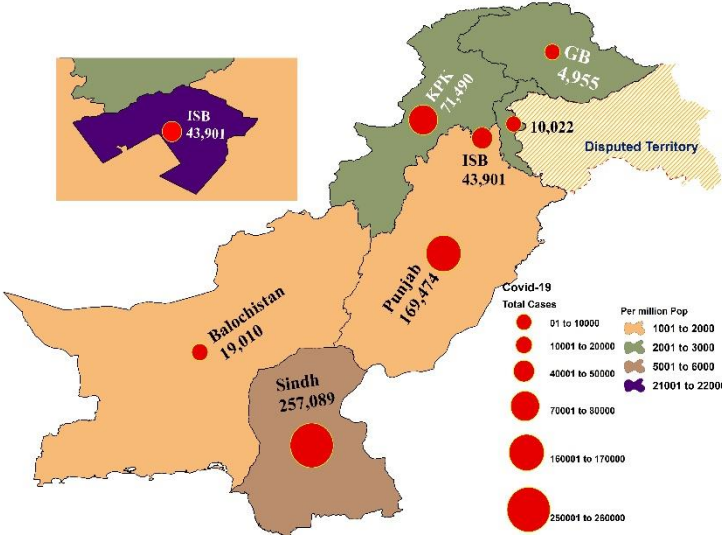

### TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.

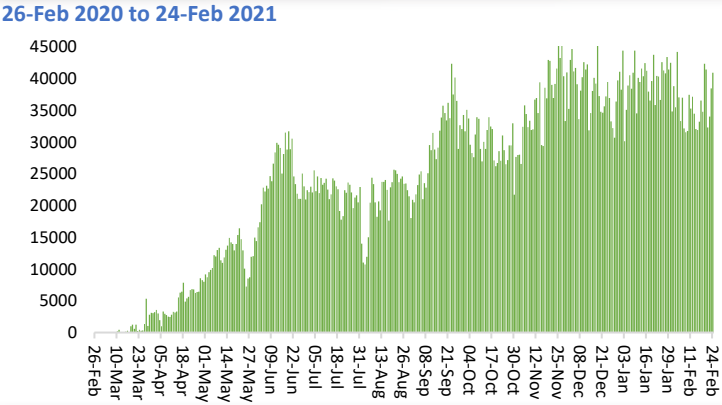


Pakistan reported **1,361** new cases of COVID-19 on **24<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **575,941** with **12,772** deaths (**CFR: 2.22%**). Out of the total **23,281** currently active cases **2,042** cases are hospitalized.

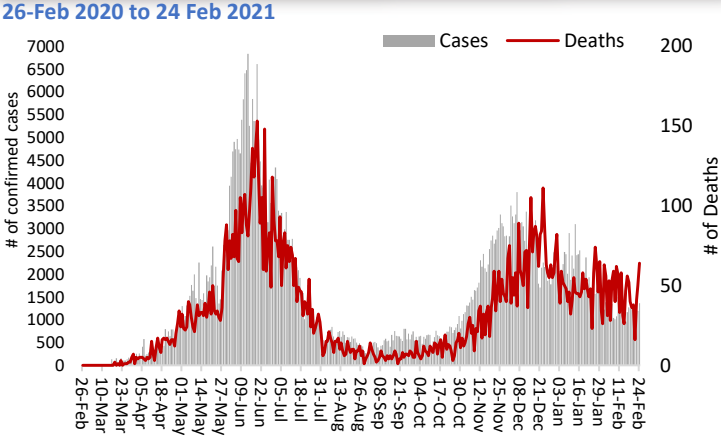

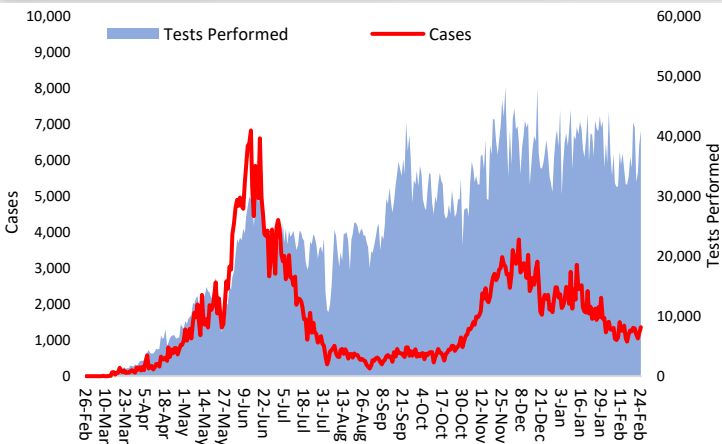
### LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

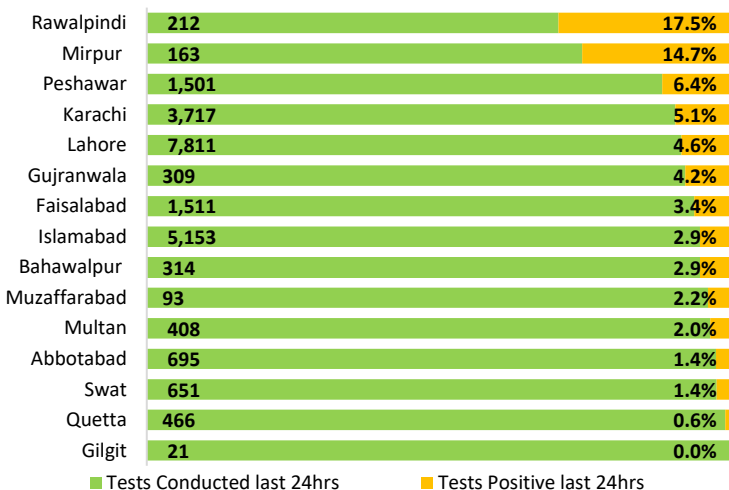
## MEETINGS & COORDINATION

World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with National Institute of Health Islamabad Provincial AIDS Control Program and provincial Public health laboratory Punjab is conducting a 3-days training on Laboratory Quality Management System (LQMS) from 23-25 February 2021 at Lahore. The objective of the training is capacity building of laboratory managers and personnel on 12 essential elements of Laboratory Quality Management System (LQMS) in line with the WHO guidance and international quality standards.
