## **Summary Table by Province**

On 24th September 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala accompanied by WHO staff visited Islamabad International Airport. The purpose of the visit was to promote the "Wear Mask, Protect Pakistan" Campaign. During the visit WHO distributed masks and IEC material among passengers and their kin.

While at the airport, Dr Palitha spoke to passengers and reiterated the importance of non-pharmaceutical measures in the prevention of COVID infection and spread. The WR advised all persons to make mask wearing a normal part of being around other people, He further cautioned on the need to ensure consistent and correct wearing, proper storage, cleaning, and disposal of masks.

The Airport authorities appreciated WHO efforts in advocacy and promotion of mask-wearing and other public health measures.
