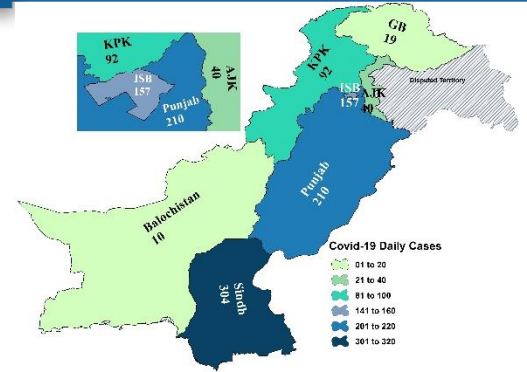

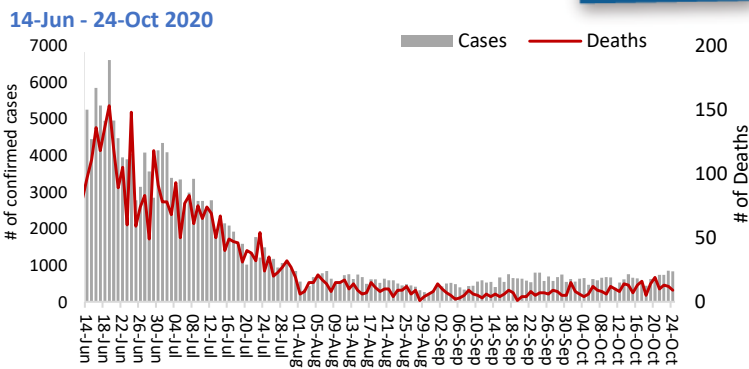
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **832** new cases of COVID-19 on **24 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **327,895** with **6,736** deaths (**CFR: 2.05%**). Out of the total **10,668** currently active cases, **834** cases are hospitalized, out of which **562 (67.39%)** are in critical condition. **9,384** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **310,491 (94.69%)** have recovered and discharged.

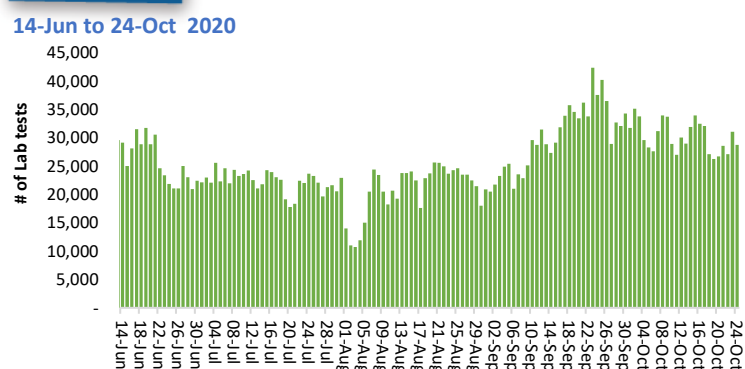
Daily Incidence by Province



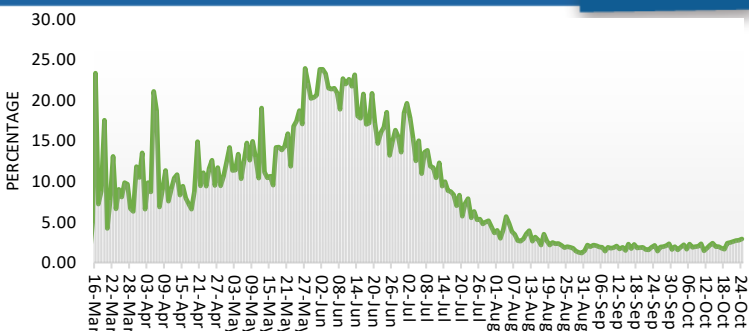
Daily Incidence/Mortality



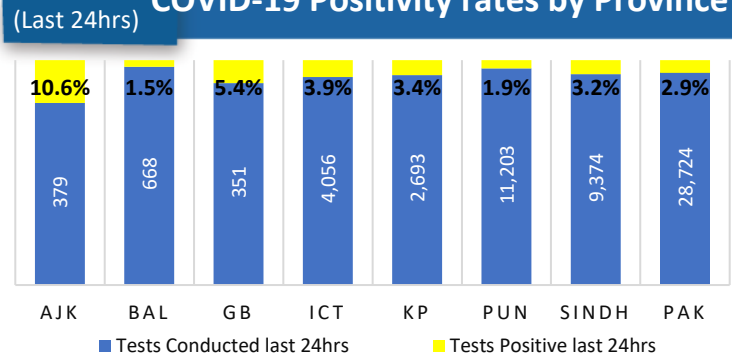
Daily Lab Tests conducted

Meetings & Coordination

The World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Department of Health, Sindh conducted third batch of 2-days coaching on Roll out of Early Essential Newborn Care (EENC) at Shaikh Zaid Women Hospital Larkana on 23-24 October 2020.

The objective of this coaching is to enhance skills of healthcare providers in conducting normal deliveries in the labor room to minimize the risk of neonatal morbidity and mortality.

19 participants attended this coaching from Regional Training Institute, Public Health School and Shaikh Zaid Women Hospital Larkana. A total of 54 participants have been trained so far in the 3 sessions held last week.



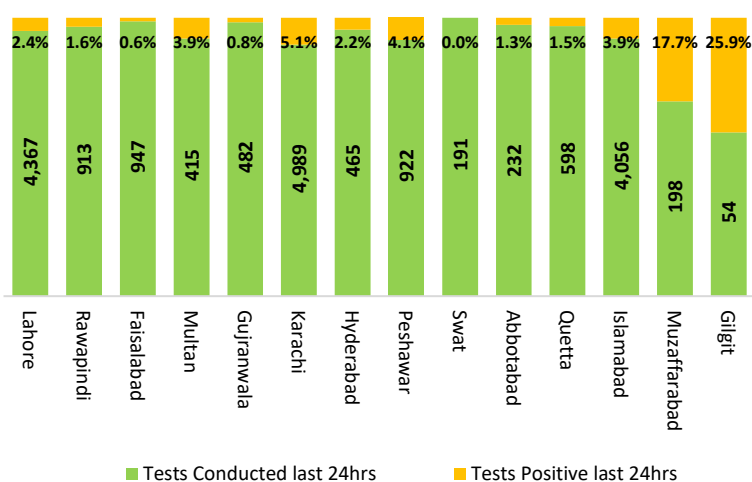
