On 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021, the Nutrition wing of Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation and Coordination (MoNHSRC), in collaboration with World Health Organization, Pakistan conducted a consultative meeting on the Development of Integrated Actional Plan for Reduction of Dietary Risk Factors of NCDs in Pakistan at the WHO Country Office, Islamabad. The meeting was attended by among others; The Vice chancellor Health Services Academy, Dr Shahzad Ali Khan, Director MoNHSRC Dr Razia Safdar, National Coordinator Nutrition, Dr. Khawaja Masuood Ahmed, and other partners.

During the meeting, the current implementation plan was reviewed and the development of a multisector action plan in line with the WHO/EMR framework for reduction in consumption of sugar, salt, and Trans Fatty Acids was initiated. Dr Khawaja appreciated WHO for the technical support towards reduction in dietary risk factors for NCDs.
