





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



Pakistan reported 1,541 new cases of COVID-19 on 25th February 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 577,482 with 12,804 deaths (CFR: 2.22%). Out of the total 22,285 currently active cases 2,018 cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 25th February 2021, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala donated 33 ambulances, 150 motorbikes, 12 double cabin vehicles and laboratory equipment on behalf of WHO to Honorable Special Assistant to Prime Minister H.E Dr Faisal Sultan. The donation is to strengthen the Government of Pakistan COVID-19 response efforts in surveillance, ensuring timely referral of patients, sample transportation and contact tracing.
