






# PAKISTAN COVID-19 **SNAPSHOT**

(Cumulative)









On 25<sup>th</sup> June 2021, WHO Country office Pakistan conducted a virtual meeting for development partners. The meeting was chaired by the WR Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala.

The purpose of the meeting was to brief the partners on the COVID-19 situation at the global level, Eastern Mediterranean Region, and the Pakistan situation and to update them on the current government strategy in the COVID-19 response.
