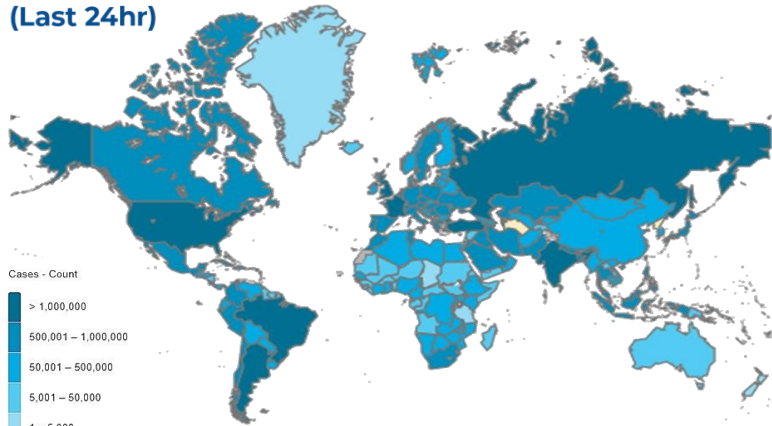
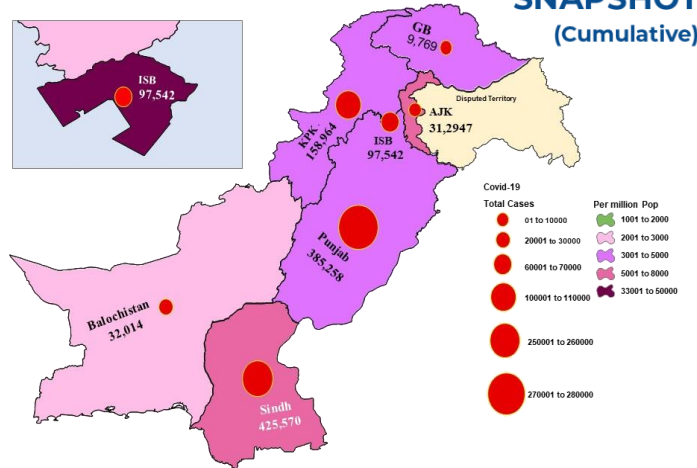

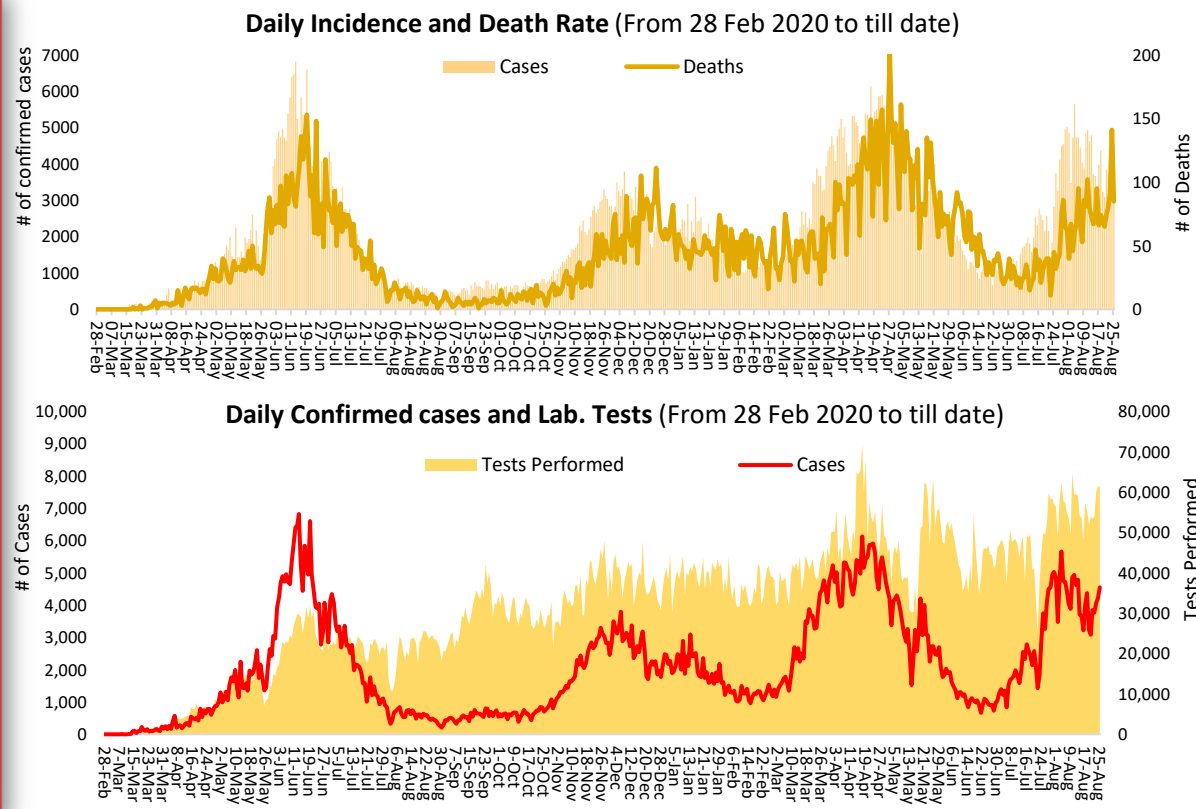

Meetings & Coordination



On 25th August 2021, the Sehat Sahulat Programme of Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination (MONHSR&C) in collaboration with World Health Organization and Marie Stopes Society Pakistan launched a pilot project for OPD health insurance in ICT. The purpose of the project is to provide financial protection for delivery of package of essential health services on outpatient basis at PHC level. The launch was graced by the Special Assistant to Prime Minister Dr. Faisal Sultan and WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala. Also in attendance were Additional Secretary Health, Barrister Nabeel Dr Zafar Mirza, Former SAPM and Advisor UHC, Director Sehat Sahulat Program, Mr. Muhammad Arshad and officials from MoNHSR&C.
