





TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,260** new cases of COVID-19 on **25 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **469,482** with **9,816** deaths **(CFR: 2.09%)**. Out of the total **39,177** currently active cases **2,840** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On Monday 21st December 2020, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala with WHO Sub Office Balochistan team met the Chief Secretary (CS) Balochistan, Capt. (R) Fazeel Asghar at his office in Quetta.

Dr Palitha, during the discussion drew attention to the low COVID-19 laboratory testing rates in Balochistan and requested the CS to take note of it. WR also advocated for the use of Rapid Antigen Tests as they are effective, cost is relatively low, and their use has been incorporated in the national testing strategy for early COVID-19 screening and surveillance. WR also briefed on the new COVID-19 variant reported in many countries and emphasized on strict implementation of preventive and control measures.

The Chief Secretary Balochistan appreciated the WHO support to the Government of Pakistan in combating the COVID-19 pandemic in the country.
