

### **Executive Summary**

Pakistan reported **1,226** new cases of COVID-19 on **25** July **2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **273,113** with **5,822** deaths (CFR: **2.13%**). Out of the total **29,867** currently active cases, **1,894** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,267** (66.89%) are in critical condition. **27,973** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **237,434** (86.93%) have recovered and discharged.


### Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan






### **COVID-19 case density/million Population**




### **Meeting & Coordination**




