



TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,315** new cases of COVID-19 on **26**th **February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **578,797** with **12,837** deaths **(CFR: 2.22%)**. Out of the total **21,554** currently active cases **1,989** cases are hospitalized.


LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

WHO Pakistan is implementing a One-Health study focusing on zoonotic transmission and sero-prevalence of Middle East Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus (MERS-CoV) in Mianwali and Bahawalpur districts of South Punjab. The objectives of this study are to estimate the prevalence of MERS-CoV infection in dromedary camels and high-risk populations (persons occupationally exposed to dromedaries). The study is being conducted in collaboration with the National Institute of Health Islamabad, the Departments of Health, Livestock and Dairy Development Punjab. To initiate phase 2 of the study in Mianwali districts, a three-day field training was conducted from 24-26 February 2021, at the District Health Development Center Mianwali. On the first and second day, the participants were trained on the study protocols, sample collection, biosafety, and waste management. The third day of the training involved a field simulation exercise.

The Chief Executive Officer Health District Mianwali, Dr Pervaiz Akhtar and Director Animal Disease Diagnostic Reporting and Surveillance (ADDRS) Lahore, Dr Ehtisham-ul-Haq appreciated the support of WHO Pakistan for conducting this study.
