


SITUATION REPORT






Pakistan reported **773** new cases of COVID-19 on **26 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **329,375** with **6,745** deaths (CFR: 2.05%). Out of the total **11,190** currently active cases, **853** cases are hospitalized, out of which **576 (67.53%)** are in critical condition. **10,337** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **311,440** (**94.55%**) have recovered and discharged.





Meetings & Coordination

Today, 27th October 2020, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Director General Health, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination inaugurated a one-day consultation session with the NCD Technical Working Group to present draft action plan on NCD and Mental Health at Ramada Hotel Islamabad.

The objective of the consultation is to solicit suggestions/feedback from the participants and agree on the way forward to accelerate implementation of the Action Plan. The consultation was attended by members of the Technical Working Groups on NCD and Mental Health, Provincial DGs and Focal Points on NCDs and Mental Health from the provinces including AJK and GB, public health experts and representatives of civil society.
