




Daily COVID-19 Pakistan Updates (Last 24hrs)




## **Executive Summary**


Pakistan reported **445** new cases of COVID-19 on **26 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **294,638** with **6,274** deaths **(CFR: 2.13%)**. Out of the total **8,803** currently active cases, **1,076** cases are hospitalized, out of which **641 (59.57%)** are in critical condition. **7,727** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **279,561 (94.88%)** have recovered and discharged.





#### **Daily Incidence by Province**







## **COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR** by Major Cities / Districts






**COVID-19** Positivity rates
