



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,176** new cases of COVID-19 on **27**th **February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **579,973** with **12,860** deaths **(CFR: 2.22%)**. Out of the total **21,836** currently active cases **1.994** cases are hospitalized.
