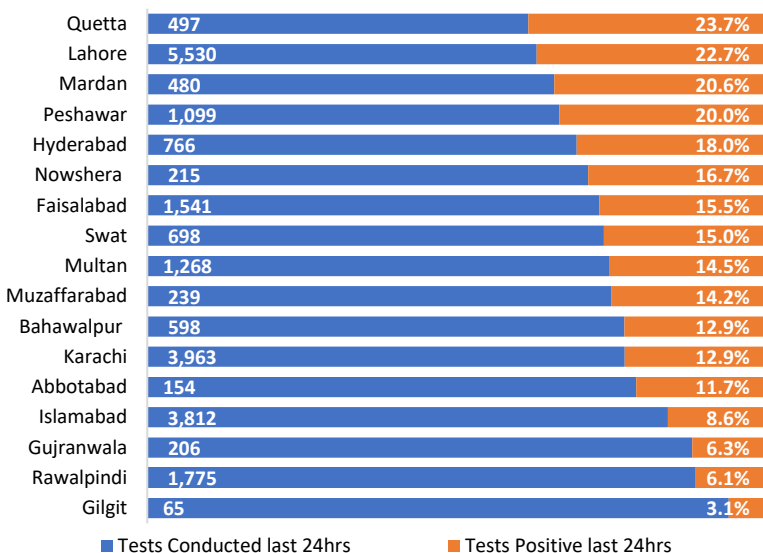
## Meeting and Coordination



On the 27<sup>th</sup> April 2021, World Health Organization, Pakistan held a virtual meeting with members of the Provincial Scholars Task Force (PSTF) at WHO Country Office, Pakistan. The purpose of the meeting was to appreciate religious leaders in advocating for good hygiene practices, wearing of mask, social distancing, and vaccination campaign against COVID-19 virus. Over 27 members of PSTF participated in the meeting including: The Chairman National Islamic Advisory Group (NIAG), Dr Suhail Hasan; Provincial PSTF leaders Mufti Shaukat Ullah, Maulana Nasim Shah; member Islamic ideological council, Dr Atta-ur-Rehman and Islamic Advisory group & Wafaq-ul-Madaris, Maulana Haneef Jhalandhri participated in the meeting. WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, briefed the religious leaders on the current situation of COVID-19 in the country and initiatives taken by WHO Pakistan in the COVID-19 Response. Dr Palitha acknowledged the contribution of religious leaders the implementation of guidelines and standard operating procedures for control of COVID-19 pandemic.
