



PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)




Meeting and Coordination




On 28th June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala attended a meeting organized by Provincial Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Polio Eradication Initiative (PEI) Staff at Provincial EOC Office Quetta, Balochistan. The Meeting was meant to appraise the WR on the progress in PEI during his support supervisory visit to the province. The meeting was chaired by the Secretary Health, Primary Healthcare Mr. Aziz Jamali.

During the meeting, the WHO/Polio Team Lead noted that since the beginning of 2021 only one case of polio had been identified. It is an indication that polio eradication activities were on course despite the COVID 19 Pandemic.

Dr Palitha commended the efforts of EOC, PEI partners and the Frontline workers in the polio eradication campaign. And stated that the progress is a positive indication to the donors.

EOC coordinator thanked WR for his technical support and counsel to the PEI program stakeholders in Balochistan.
