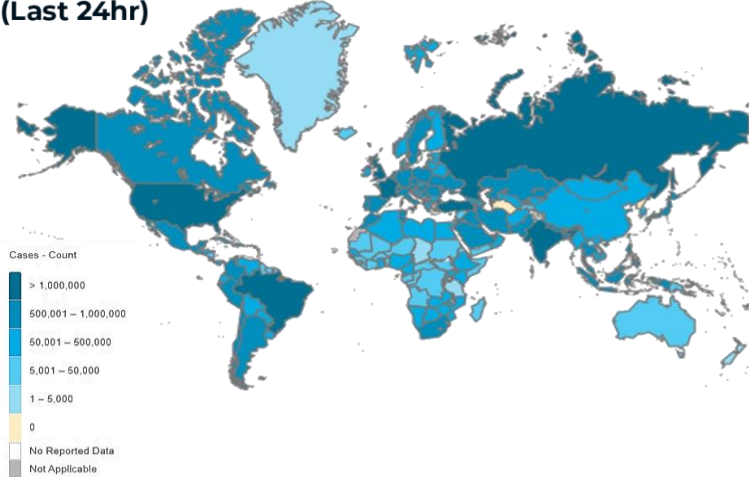




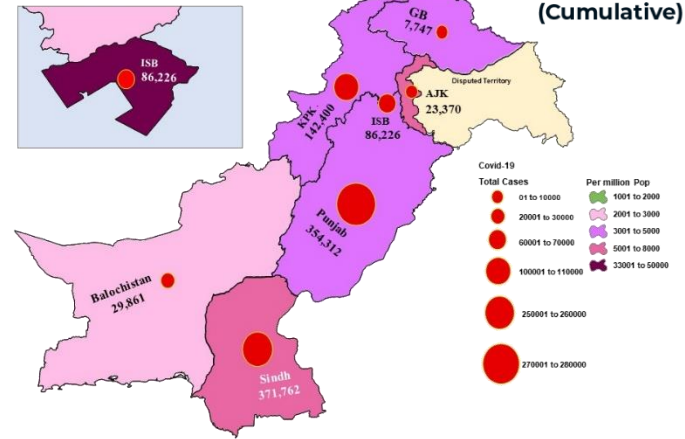

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

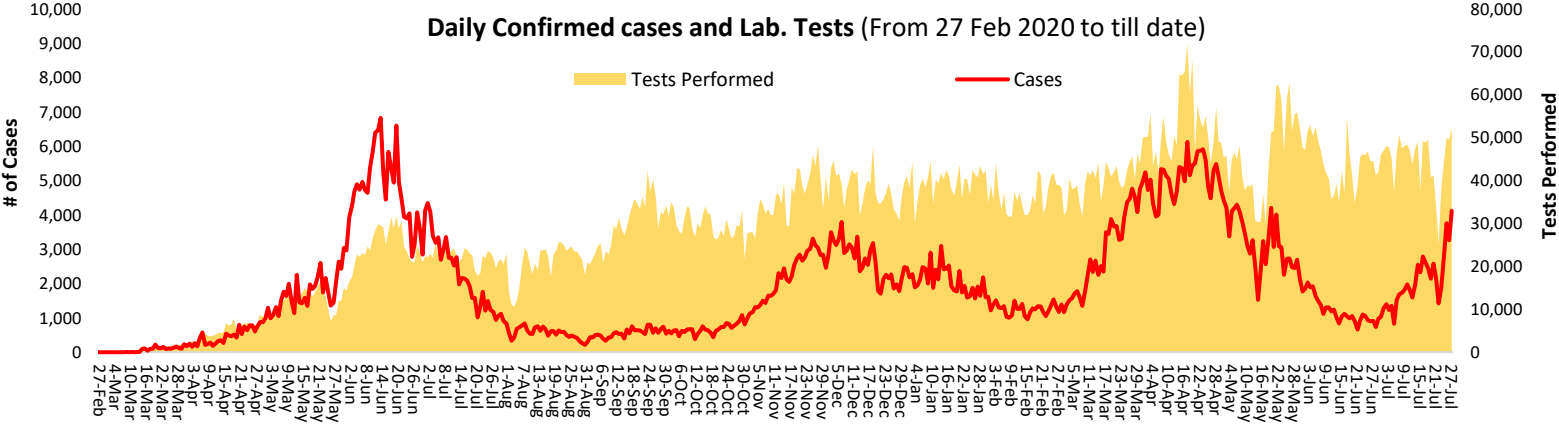
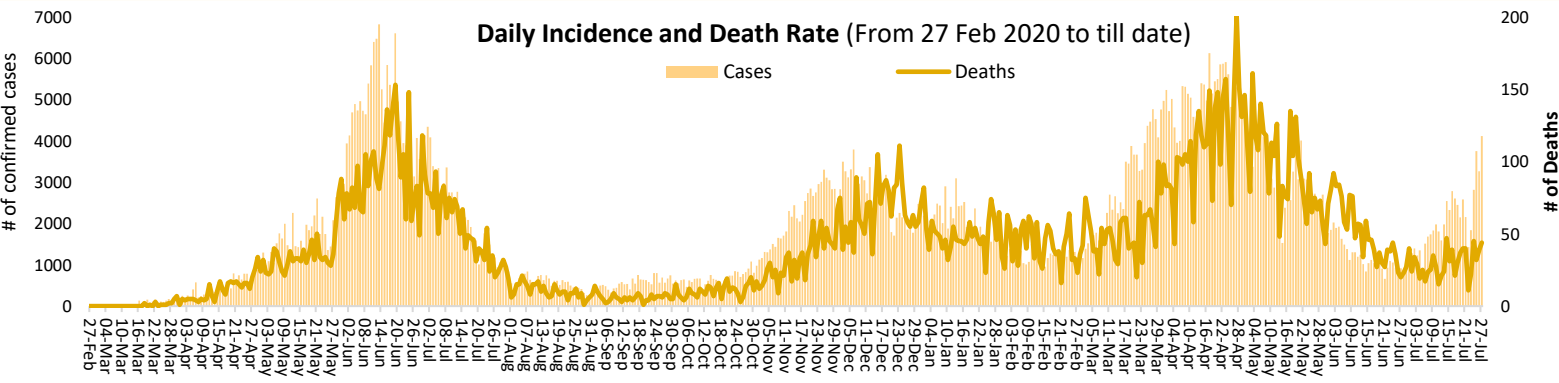

Meetings & Coordination

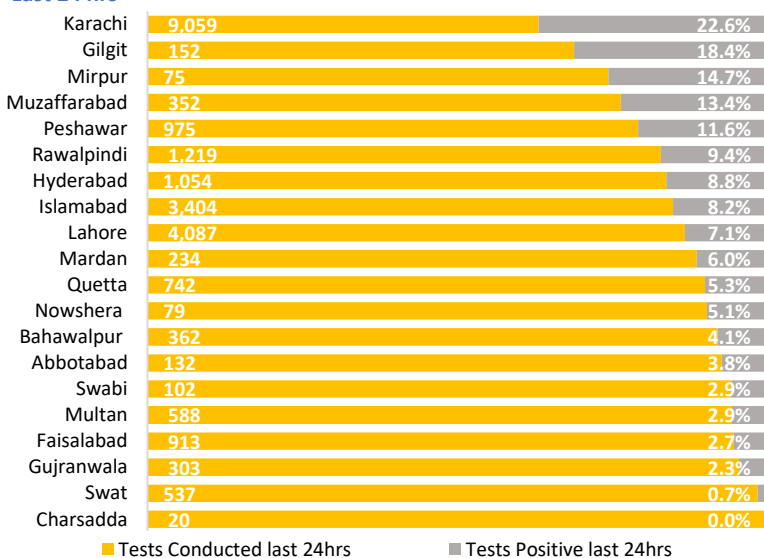


The Provincial Health Department of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) with support from World Health Organization, Pakistan conducted training on the management of Cutaneous Leishmaniasis. The training was conducted at Nathia Gali, KP from 9th to 10th July 2021. The objective of the training is to update health workers on the current WHO recommended approaches to prevention and management of Leishmaniasis. A total of 20 participants drawn from 13 highly endemic merged districts of KP province benefitted.

The closing ceremony was graced by the Hon. Secretary to Health Mr. Imtiaz Ali Shah, Director General Health Services, Dr Muhammad Niaz, Additional Director General Health, Dr Ikram and program manager IVMP, Dr Shaista. In his speech, the Secretary health reiterated the importance of refresher trainings and appreciated the support from WHO towards prevention and management of leishmaniasis in Pakistan.
