


# SITUATION REPORT COVID-19 PAKISTAN







Pakistan reported **825** new cases of COVID-19 on **27 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **330,200** with **6,759** deaths (CFR: **2.11%**). Out of the total **11,627** currently active cases, **894** cases are hospitalized, out of which **611 (68.34%)** are in critical condition. **10,733** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **311,814 (94.43%)** have recovered and discharged.









(Last 24hrs) COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province

# Meetings & Coordination

Yesterday, 27th October 2020, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Deputy Team Lead Polio, Dr Ibrahim Yalahow, visited Mirpur in Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJK). The objectives of the visit included monitoring of the Permanent Transit Team (PTP), iinauguration of October 2020 Sub National Immunization Days (SNIDs) at Margla PTP, Mirpur and acknowledgment of the services provided by polio workers during COVID-19.

During the meeting with Secretary Hhealth AJK, Dr Ahsan, WHO handed over emergency supplies worth 4.04 Million PKR to AJK province. The donation included Cardiac monitors, Oxygen concentrators, Resuscitation Kits, Suction Machines, hand sanitizers, face mask, surgical cap/gown, googles etc.

The secretary health AJ&K expressed his gratitude to WHO for the continued support it is rendering to Pakistan in various situations including the COVID-19 and the floods response.
