



On 27th October 2021, The World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with The Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination (MoNHSR&C) organized an awareness walk to commemorate the World Polio Day 2021. The event took place at WHO Country Office, Islamabad and was graced by WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, Director General Health Dr Rana Safdar, Deputy Director Programs MONHSR&C Dr Samra Mazhar and Vice-Chancellor Health Services Academy Dr Shahzad Khan.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha appealed for solidarity in the polio fight. He noted that current public health efforts and reduction in cases is an opportunity to make Pakistan polio free. The DG Health appreciated the community leaders and health workers for the high-quality campaigns. He applauded WHO for the technical and logistical support to the polio program.
