

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **936** new cases of COVID-19 on **27 July 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **275,225** with **5,865** deaths (CFR: **2.13%**). Out of the total **26,924** currently active cases, **1,943** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,217** (**62.63%**) are in critical condition. **24,981** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **242,436** (**88.08%**) have recovered and discharged.

Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan






COVID-19 case density/million Population




Meeting & Coordination




Trends of COVID-19 cases, hospitalized, on ventilator & Deaths






COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by districts Last 24 hrs 5.71 250 4.55
