

SITUATION REPORT COVID-19 PAKISTAN









Pakistan reported **566** new cases of COVID-19 on **27 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **310,841** with **6,466** deaths (CFR: **2.08%**). Out of the total **8,353** currently active cases, **681** cases are hospitalized, out of which **451** (**66.22%**) are in critical condition. **7,672** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **296,022** (**95.23%**) have recovered and discharged.




Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate






(Last 24hrs) COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province

Meetings and Coordination

Today, 28th September 2020, WHO Pakistan organized virtual partner briefing. The meeting was chaired by the WHO Country representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala. The country representative briefed partners on the current COVID-19 situation and response by the Government.

During the meeting the WR. launched case control study findings on the COVID-19 mortality and its associated risk factors in 4 major hospitals in KP and a video detailing WHO activity in response to COVID-19. The WR. Applauded the donor partner for supporting Pakistan through WHO. In his closing remark, the WR requested partners to continue supporting the Government to maintain the gain in controlling COVID-19.
