
PAKISTAN CEVID-19 SITUATION REPORT





Meeting and Coordination



On the 29th May 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala inaugurated a Tobacco Cessation Clinic at the 'Tobacco free' Diabetic Centre, Murre Expressway, Islamabad. The activity was organized by The Diabetic Centre in collaboration with WHO and the Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination (MONHSR&C). In attendance was the Director Programs (II), MONHSR&C, Dr Samra Mazhar.

During his speech, Dr Palitha noted that the joint collaborative activities on tobacco control have led to: Development of large-sized pictorial health warning; ban on designated smoking areas in enclosed public places; ban on the sale of loose cigarettes; ban on point of sale; and raised tobacco taxation.

Dr Palitha envisioned that Pakistan can achieve the target of reduction in tobacco use; 30 % reduction by 2025, if the current momentum is maintained.
