



#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**



Pakistan reported **1,776** new cases of COVID-19 on **28 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **475,085** with **9,992** deaths **(CFR: 2.10%)**. Out of the total **39,599** currently active cases **2,756** cases are hospitalized.

#### **MEETINGS & COORDINATION**

Enhanced Outreach Activity (EOA) Phase XIV is currently underway in 27 districts of Sindh Province. As of 28 December 2020 (day 9) of the activity in Karachi, Hyderabad and Mirpurkhas and day 3 for Shaheed Benazirabad, Larkana and Sukkur Division; a total of 303,014 children were immunized and 36,571 women were vaccinated for Tetanus Toxoid(TT).

The goal of the Enhanced Outreach Activity is to provide immunization coverage for children who went unvaccinated due to the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020. It is an initiative taken by World Health Organization Pakistan to support the provincial department of health.
