



Pakistan reported 1,078 new cases of COVID-19 on 29 October 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 332,186 with 6,795 deaths (CFR: 2.04%). Out of the total 11,864 currently active cases, 808 cases are hospitalized, out of which 632 (78.22%) are in critical condition. 11,056 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of 313,527 (94.38%) have recovered and discharged.







COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province (Last 24hrs)


