

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **1,114** new cases of COVID-19 on **29** July **2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **277,402** with **5,924** deaths (CFR: **2.13%**). Out of the total **25,347** currently active cases, **1,850** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,179** (**63.72%**) are in critical condition. **23,497** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **246,131** (**88.72%**) have recovered and discharged.

Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan






COVID-19 case density/million Population

Daily Mortality in Pakistan









Meeting & Coordination

The DG Health (CDA) expressed his gratitude to WHO for their continued support to Pakistan in combating COVID-19 Pandemic.










