


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE





Pakistan reported 1,599 new cases of COVID-19 on 30 January 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 544,813 with 11,657 deaths (CFR: 2.14%). Out of the total 33,182 currently active cases 2,591 cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial Department of Health Balochistan conducted a 2 days Provincial Training of Trainers (TOT) on implementation of Health Resources and Services Availability Monitoring System (HeRAM) in 33 districts of Balochistan. The training was conducted at Serena Hotel, Quetta from 28-29 January 2021. Director General Health Services Balochistan, Dr Ali Nasir Bugti inaugurated the training. Twenty-two (22) Master Trainers comprising of Heath department staff at provincial and divisional level and WHO staff were trained. The objectives of the training were to train Master Trainers on the HeRAMS approaches, its Core Principles and implantation phases. Mr Ahmed Murshid from Regional Office (EMRO) conducted sessions on HeRAMS Standard Data Modules and field data collection tools. These master trainers will conduct divisional level trainings and train data collectors from the districts in their respective divisions. Provincial Secretary Health Balochistan, Dr Noor Ul Haq Baloch graced the closing session. In his closing remarks Dr Noor, appreciated WHO Pakistan support for the HeRAM activity in the Balochistan province.
