


SITUATION REPORT







Pakistan reported **807** new cases of COVID-19 on **30** October 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **332,993** with **6,806** deaths (CFR: 2.04%). Out of the total **12,121** currently active cases, **838** cases are hospitalized, out of which **669** (**79.83%**) are in critical condition. **11,283** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **314,066** (**94.32%**) have recovered and discharged.




(Last 24hrs) COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province
