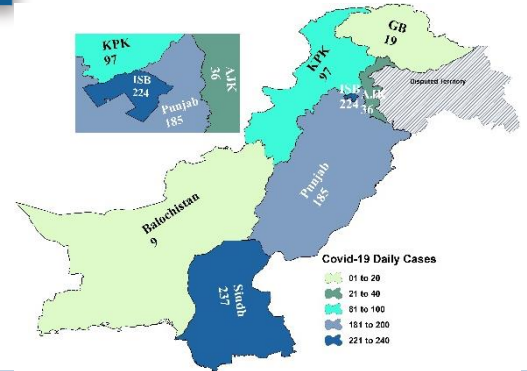

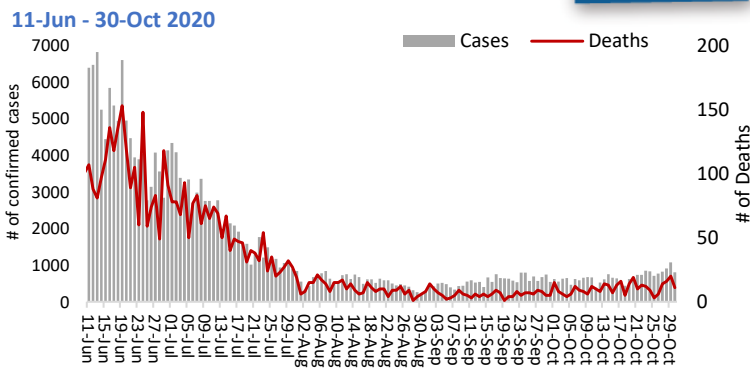
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **807** new cases of COVID-19 on **30 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **332,993** with **6,806** deaths (**CFR: 2.04%**). Out of the total **12,121** currently active cases, **838** cases are hospitalized, out of which **669** (**79.83%**) are in critical condition. **11,283** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **314,066** (**94.32%**) have recovered and discharged.

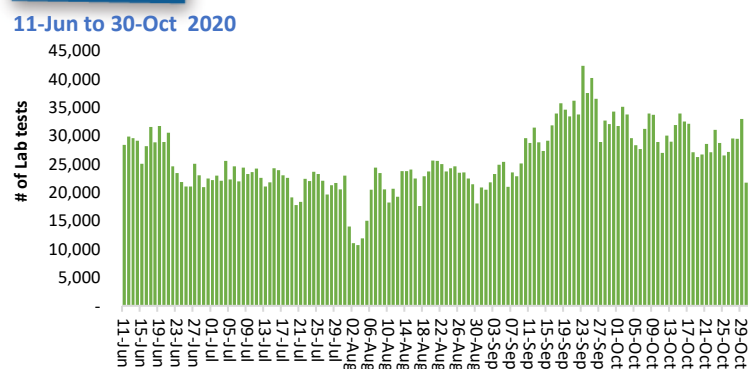
Daily Incidence by Province



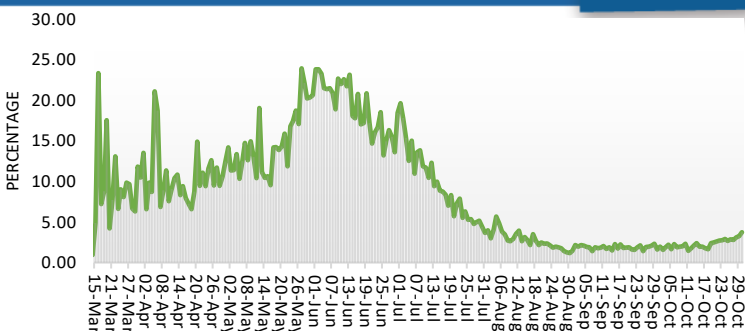
Daily Incidence/Mortality



Daily Lab Tests conducted

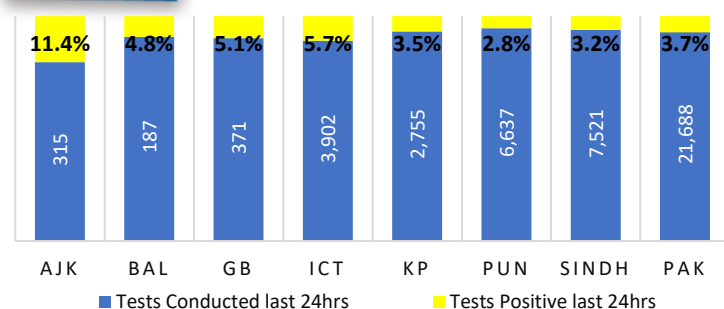


Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate

During the meeting Dr Palitha presented a copy of the WHO's newsletter and COVID-19 daily situation report to the ambassador of Switzerland in Pakistan.



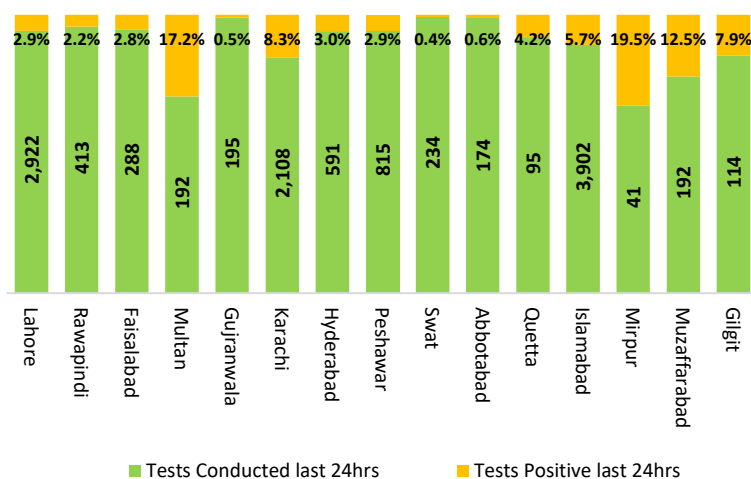
