



# **Executive Summary**


Pakistan reported 213 new cases of COVID-19 on 30 August 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 295,849 with 6,294 deaths (CFR: 2.12%). Out of the total 8,873 currently active cases, 1,088 cases are hospitalized, out of which 604 (55.51%) are in critical condition. 7,785 COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of 280,682 (94.89%) have recovered and discharged.

# **Daily Incidence by Province**









# **COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR** by Major Cities / Districts






