

Classifications of PHC centers' levels:

- MOH Level (1) provides:
- Preventive services: mother and child health care and immunization .
 - Curative services: first aid.

- MOH Level (2) provides:
- Preventive services: mother and child health care, and immunization .
 - Curative services: General Practitioner (GP) medical care.
 - Laboratory (in some clinics)

- MOH Level (3) provides:
- Preventive services: mother and child health care, immunization, family planning and dental.
 - Curative services: GP and medical specialist.
 - Laboratory.
 - Health education

- MOH Level (4) provides:
- Preventive services: mother and child health care, immunization, family planning and dental.
 - Curative services: GP and medical specialist care and dental care.
 - Gynecology and obstetric.
 - Laboratory.
 - Radiology.
 - Health education
 - Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
