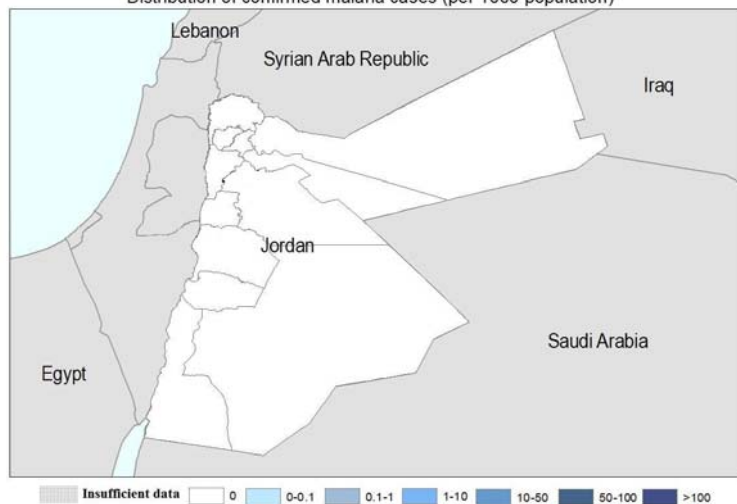


Distribution of confirmed malaria cases (per 1000 population)



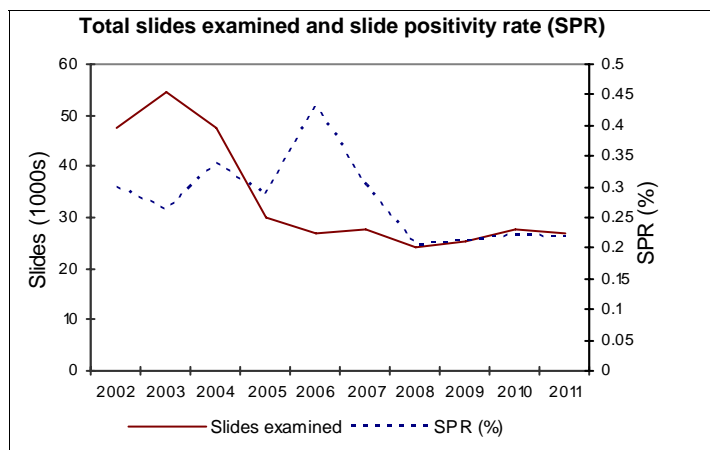
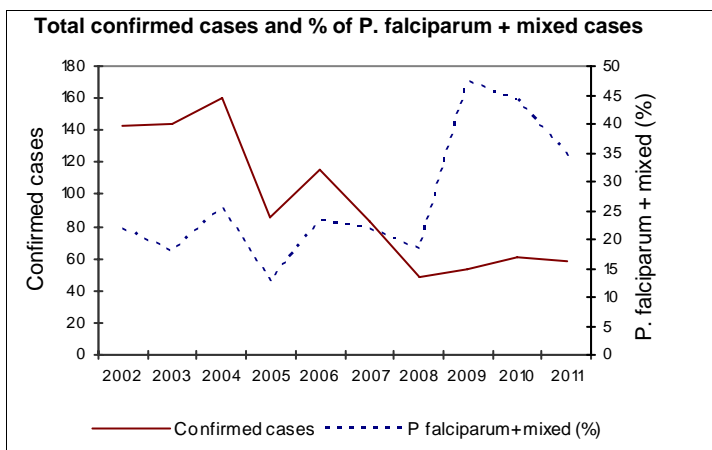
Jordan is free from local malaria transmission and has 0.7% of reported cases of the malaria-free countries. The last local case was in 1970.

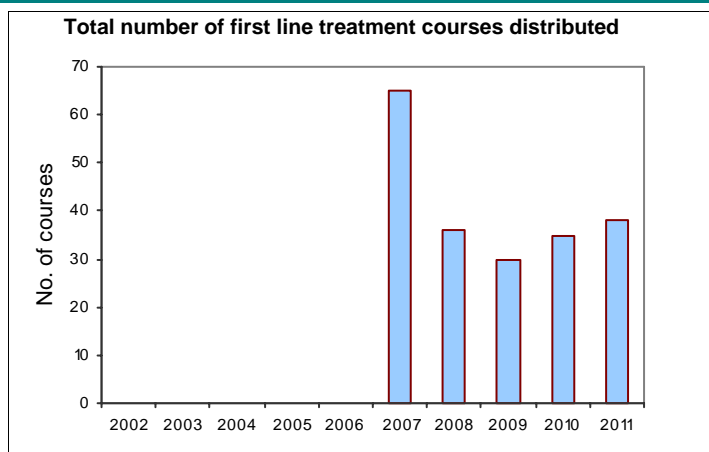
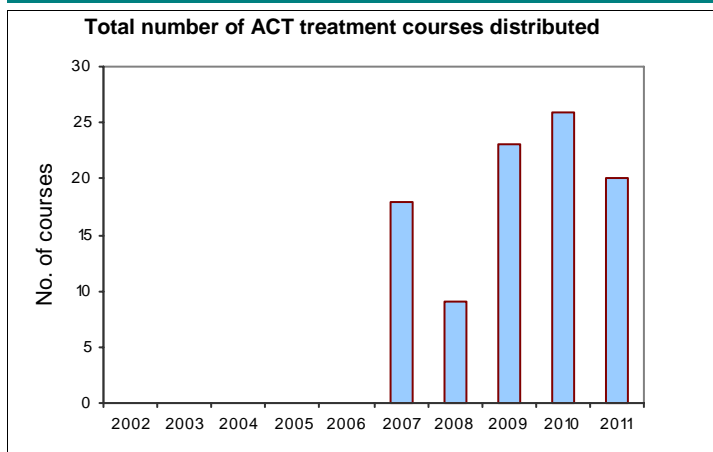
