


Distribution of confirmed malaria cases (per 1000 population)





In 2011, it was estimated that about 45.2% of the population of the Eastern Mediterranean Region countries was living in areas with risk of local malaria transmission. In that year, countries in the Region reported 1139476 confirmed malaria cases which is 37.3% of the total reported malaria cases in the Region.





