

In 2011, the number of locally transmitted malaria cases decreased by 81.3% compared with 2002. During the period 2009 to 2011 the average number of reported locally transmitted cases was 2678.






#### Confirmed cases and % of local cases

#### Total slides examined and slide positivity rate (SPR)




