### HIGHLIGHTS


- 40% of the new cases are female and 60% are male.
- Based on cases reported in 8 days, cities with highest new infections were: Riyadh (805), Makkah (723), Hufuf (562), Khamis Mushait (446), Dammam (440), Madina (426), Jeddah (379) and Buraidah (359).
- On 6 and 7 August, MoH published new infections by region: Al Sharkia (524), Makkah (517), Asir (458), Riyadh (411), and Al-Qasim (267).
- Saudi Arabia will host the Riyadh Global Digital Health Summit on 11-12 August, to discuss the vital role of digital health in the fight against current and future pandemics.
- MoH have carried out 153,000 inspection visits to health facilities
- and registered 5,000 violations with closure of 150 establishments.
- Reduction of new infections which was outpaced by recoveries,
- reducing number of active cases and critical cases.
- Successful completion of Hajj and quarantine of pilgrims returning home for 14 days.
- · Saudi Arabia is training dogs to sniff out individuals infected with coronavirus at all customs entry points.


