IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS

Probable COVID-19 case:


A patient who meets clinical criteria (see *Important Definitions* in situation reports of last week) AND is a contact of a probable or confirmed case, or epidemiologically linked to a cluster with at least one confirmed case.
 A suspect case with chest imaging showing findings suggestive of COVID-19 disease.
 A person with recent onset of anosmia (loss of smell) or ageusia (loss of taste) in the absence of any other identified cause.
 Death, not otherwise explained, in an adult with respiratory distress preceding death AND was a contact of a probable or confirmed case.

Confirmed COVID-19 case:

A person with laboratory confirmation of COVID-19 infection, irrespective of clinical signs and symptoms.
