

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 25 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 8 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- The confirmed cases reached 2,932 up to 7th of April, numbers for the 8th of April are still to be released later today.
- Out of a total of 2,932 confirmed cases, a total of 631 recovered and were discharged and 41 died; there are 2,260 active cases;
- First group of 196 Saudis out of 790 stranded in Bahrain have arrived to the Eastern Province on board a convoy of 12 buses, 4 hotels were assigned for their isolation.
- 650 Saudi doctors on scholarships in Germany provide medical care to COVID-19 patients.
- Number of sanitizer factories has risen to 35 in Saudi Arabia, with their production capacity exceeding 1.4 million liters per week.
- Cabinet stressed in a virtual session that Saudi Arabia is dealing with coronavirus crisis with all transparency and clarity.




