Situation Report No. 63 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 30 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- 4,843 new cases were recorded in 3 days, bringing total cases to 83,384. Of the new cases, 42% were Saudis, 27% were females and 12% were children.
- 7,861 new recoveries, bringing total to 58,883.
- 55 new mortalities bringing total to 480. Mortalities were: 5 Saudis (in Riyadh, Makkah, and Jeddah), mortalities among non-Saudis were in Makkah, Riyadh, Jeddah, Madinah, Dammam, Taif, Buraida, Hofuf, Khobar and Jazan; age range 30-85.
- There are 24,021 active cases, 441 of them in critical condition.
- A total of 807,000 PCR tests were conducted.
- Ministry of Interior: SAR 10,000 penalty for establishments not complying with the precautionary measures, and for those intentionally violating them. Maximum of 50 people allowed in social and family gatherings, as well as social events.
- General Authority of Civil Aviation: domestic flights will resume on Sunday in 11 airports and in 13 airports on Monday; social distancing will be applied in airplanes and those not wearing face masks will not be permitted to travel.
- Reopening of Mosques with precautionary measures.
- WHO released two new documents: key planning recommendations for mass gatherings in the context of COVID-19; and, technical guidance for the prevention




